

First Monday Heavy Pick-Up

Material is to be placed curbside no earlier than the Friday preceding the first Monday; and, not later than 7:30 a.m. of the first Monday.

Maximum weight of any individual item is not to exceed 140 lbs.

Eligible for Curbside Residential Collection

Brush, Limbs, Shrub Clippings
Furniture & Mattresses
Carpet
Water Heater
Discarded Clothing
Fence Pickets & Posts
Clothes Dryer (not Washer)
Dishwasher
Christmas Trees
Open & Dry Paint Cans
Bicycles
Packing Boxes

NOT Eligible for Curbside Collection

Tires or Batteries
Anything with a Gasoline Engine
Air Conditioners
Clothes Washers
Refrigerators or Freezers
Televisions or Computer Components
Any Liquids
Propane or Butane Tanks
High Gas Pressure Bottles
Construction Debris
Concrete, Bricks or Concrete Blocks
Sand, Dirt, or Similar Loose Materials

NOTE: When a property owner/occupant contracts for any type of construction, landscaping or lot clearing, the contractor is responsible for removal and disposal of all waste. This includes but is not limited to carpet, fencing, siding, discarded cabinets, windows, wall board, insulation, ductwork, piping, framing lumber, roofing, etc.
