



VOLUNTARY EVACUATION ORDER


WHEREAS, the City of Shoreacres, Texas, is in the cone of uncertainty for the path of Hurricane Laura,

WHEREAS, the Mayor of the City of Shoreacres, Texas, has determined that a public safety threat is imminent,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF SHOREACRES, TEXAS:

1. That a voluntary evacuation is hereby declared for the City of Shoreacres, Texas, pursuant to §418.108(a) of the Texas Government Code
2. Pursuant to §418 108(b) of the Texas Government Code, the voluntary evacuation order shall continue for a period of not more than three days from the date of this declaration unless continued or renewed by the City- Council of the City of Shoreacres, Texas.
3. Pursuant to §418.108(c) of the Texas Government Code, this declaration of a voluntary evacuation shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be filed promptly with the City Secretary.
4. Pursuant to §418 108(d) of the Texas Government Code, this declaration of a voluntary activates the city emergency management plan.
5. That this proclamation shall take effect immediately from and after its issuance.
