

## **VOLUNTARY EVACUATION ORDER**

WHEREAS, the City of Shoreacres, Texas, is in the cone of uncertainty for the path of Hurricane Laura,

WHEREAS. the Mayor of the City of Shoreacres. Texas, has determined that a public safety threat is imminent,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF SHOREACRES. TEXAS:

- 1. That a voluntary evacuation is hereby declared for the City of Shoreacres, Texas, pursuant to §418.108(a) of the Texas Government Code
- 2. Pursuant to §418 108(b) of the Texas Government Code, the voluntary evacuation order shall continue for a period of not more than three days from the date of this declaration unless continued or renewed by the City- Council of the City of Shoreacres. Texas.
- 3. Pursuant to §418.108(c) of the Texas Government Code, this declaration of a voluntary evacuation shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be filed promptly with the City Secretary.
- 4. Pursuant to §418 108(d) of the Texas Government Code, this declaration of a voluntary activates the city emergency management plan.
- 5. That this proclamation shall lake effect immediately from and after its issuance.
