Disposing of Trash, Limbs, & Recycling

Household Waste must be placed in containers, bags or bundles. There is no limit to the number of containers, bags or bundles to be collected at each house. HOWEVER, cans exceeding 35 gallons, or any can, bag, or bundle that exceeds 50 lbs in weight will not be collected. Allied Waste Management may refuse to collect any refuse which has not been placed in an appropriate container.

Allied Waste Management is not required to make special trips to pick up refuse which has not been placed curbside by 7:00 a.m. on the day of pick up.

Allied Waste Management will pick up heavy trash with certain stipulations.

Bulky Waste will be picked up curbside on Mondays and Thursdays. Allied Waste Management will not pick up construction debris, building materials or appliances with coolant, unless it is tagged that the Freon has been removed.


Limbs and Brush must be in bundles (tied or untied), less than 4-feet in length, 2-feet high, 3-feet wide and less than 50 lbs in weight.

Grass Clippings must be bagged. There is a limit of five (5) bags of grass clippings per pick-up day.

Storm Debris collection is not included in the city's refuse collection contract.

Special arrangements can be made at the owner's expense for expanded brush pick up or heavy pick-up.
